Attention, however: according to the ECTS rules one can recover **at most** 2 laboratories during the semester and at most 2 laboratories in the examination period, before the exam. If more than 4 unfinished laboratories are accumulated, the case is considered irrecoverable, and the student has to sign the contract for the whole course in the next year.
